EVENT RULES:

PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

1. This event is an INDIVIDUAL event.
2. Participants can submit up to 2 photos per entry.
3. Size of the photograph - any one side of the photo should be 8 inches. Photographs should be original & relevant to the topic.
4. Participants should write down: Caption, Camera and photograph details (Camera type, Shutter speed, Aperture, ISO), location and date.
5. Photographs should be submitted along with registration fees on or before 27th January.
6. TOPICS ARE AS FOLLOWS:
 - Reflections
 - Life Around us
 - Aqua vision
7. Participants are required to collect their photographs at the end of the fest i.e. 1st February 2011.

MODEL MAKING:

1. This is a **TEAM EVENT**. The team should comprise of 2 participants.
2. The event is on 31st January.
3. The topic for the model making is "Eco- Home"
4. Participants are requested to keep their models ready and come by 9.00a.m. to display their models on 31st January.

POSTER PRESENTATION:

1. The event is held on 31st January
2. This is a team Event. The team will consist a maximum of 2 participants.
3. The topics for the presentation are:
 - Nature vs. Nurture
 - Garbage: The revolution
 - Drinking water: Let the truth be told.
4. The poster should be of 70*70cm

QUIZ COMPETITION

1. This is a **TEAM EVENT**. The team should comprise of 2 participants.
2. An elimination round will be conducted on 31st January. Four teams will be selected for finals on the same day itself.
3. Elimination rounds will consist of multiple choice questions based on general science.

POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

1. The event is on 31st January.
2. This is a **TEAM EVENT**. A team can comprise of 2 participants.
3. Topics for the presentation are as follows:
 - Eco-Terrorism
 - Slave to Entertainment
 - Blue Gold: Water At Wars
4. Abstract of the topics must be submitted by 25th January 2011
5. Participants are required to register at the earliest for this event.
6. Participants may be questioned by the audience and judges.

JAM(Just a Minute)

1. The event is on 31st January.
2. This is an Individual Event.
3. Topics will be provided on the spot.
4. Participants will be provided 2 minutes to prepare for the session and one minute to speak on the given topic.

WOW(Wealth out of Waste)

1. This event will be held on 1st February.
2. This is a team event .The team will consist a maximum of 2 participants.
3. The materials will be provided to the participants.
4. Participants will be provided a time limit of 50 minutes.

T-SHIRT PAINTING

1. This is a TEAM EVENT. The team should comprise of 2 participants.
2. The event is on 1st February.
3. Topics will be given on the spot. T-shirts will be provided to the participants.
4. Participants are required to bring their own fabric paints and painting equipment.
5. Time limit of 45 minutes will be given.

SHORT MOVIE MAKING

1. This is a TEAM EVENT. The team can comprise of 2 participants.
2. Entries should be submitted by 27th January.
3. The movie clip should not exceed 3 minutes.
4. The movie should be ORIGINAL, self made. Any internet lift-offs will be disqualified.
5. The theme of this competition is, "Man Who Had Everything", "Fighting back" & "Environment: Creation and Destruction".
6. Movies will be screened on 1st February. Results will be announced on the same day itself.

ECO-FRIENDLY RANGOLI COMPETITION:

1. This event will be held on 1st February.
2. This is a team event. The team will consist a maximum of 2 participants.
3. The participants are expected to bring their own materials.
4. The theme for the competition is "Art in Nature"
5. The participants will be provided a time limit of one hour.

FASHION SHOW:

1. This is a TEAM EVENT. The team should comprise of a maximum of 4 participants.
2. The event is on 1st February.
3. The ramp walk should not exceed three minutes.
4. The soundtrack should be brought by the participants.
5. The fabrics should be eco-friendly (Khadi/Cotton/Jute) and should depict an environmental cause/message.
6. One of the members should be able to explain about the outfit and its message.
7. The costumes are expected to be decent.
8. The participants are expected to be at the venue at least 30minutes prior to the time of the event.
